



### **C3: Blended Mobility of Higher Education Students related to the course on Entrepreneurship for Resilient, Smart and Sustainable Cities**

The C3 was related to the course on Entrepreneurship for Resilient, Smart and Sustainable Cities, i.e., the fourth intellectual output of the RESICITIES project. It was organized and hosted by Porto Business School, the partner university of the consortium that was fully responsible for the development and delivery of the referred course. It was held during the week from July 11 to July 15, 2022.

Participation in the Mobility Week was not mandatory for the students to achieve a certificate, but it was a good opportunity for students to know different contexts and ecosystems, to meet foreign lecturers in person, and to establish international networks with other students and companies. It also contributed to participants achieving greater learning outcomes and giving the opportunity of enhanced teamwork and developing critical thinking among other students and the facilitators. During the Mobility Week, participants also visited different actors in the city's entrepreneurial ecosystem and worked together to devise ideas and solutions for urban challenges.
