

## C5: Blended Mobility of Higher Education Students related to the course on Innovation for Sustainable and Smart Urban Planning

Scheduled for July 3-6, 2023 in Nice, France (IPAG Business School)

This learning, teaching and training activity (LTTA) will be related to the course on Innovation for Sustainable and Smart Urban Planning (IO3) that will have the contribution of all partner universities as described in the section under IO3.

Due to the contribution of all partner institutions of the consortium in the teaching activities of this course both in the online modules and in the mobility week this LTTA will be in fact composed by the following activity:

- Blended mobility of higher education students
- Invited teachers at higher education intensive study Programmes

The course is composed of five modules as described in the section about IO3. IPAG Business School will be responsible for two modules, PBS will be responsible for one module, CTU will be responsible for one module and UiS will also be responsible for one module. Online lessons will be provided by assigned lecturers of each partner university in different scheduled dates for each module from the end of May 2023 until June 23, 2023. After the online lectures and assignments selected students will take part in the Mobility Week to be held in the beginning of July (July 3-6, 2023) in the premises of IPAG Business School in Nice, France. The assigned lecturers on behalf of each partner university will also participate in the Mobility Week with the provision of additional seminars and case studies. Together the invited lecturers will create an environment that encourages collaboration in teamwork among students in their respective subjects and will provide guidance on group dynamics and communication and will offer feedback on the process and outcome of the team's work.

A detailed programme of the Mobility Week will be provided later in the beginning of May 2023 and will be published in the website of RESICITIES project together with all detailed programme of the referred course and instructions for free registration.

The topics to be addressed during the Mobility Week will be related to the following modules of the course:

Module 1 – Introduction to Open urban innovation in the context of resilient, smart and sustainable cities (under the responsibility of IPAG)

- Module 2 Urban Labs & Collaborative business models (under the responsibility of PBS)
- Module 3 Crisis management in urban context (under the responsibility of IPAG)
- Module 4 Security and Urban Planning (under the responsibility of UiS)
- Module 5 Urban planning for climate change (under the responsibility of CTU)



As with other Mobility Weeks associated with other courses offered by the RESICITIES consortium, the Mobility week associated with this course will be an optional component, however recommended for students who will participate in the course.

Thus, all students who successfully complete the online course modules will already be eligible to receive a course completion certificate. However, students who, in addition to completing the online modules, also successfully participate in the Mobility Week will receive a certificate specifying a higher amount of study load, which in turn may award students with recognition of a higher amount of ECTS credits.

The number of students who will participate in Mobility Week on behalf of each partner university will be specified here later.
